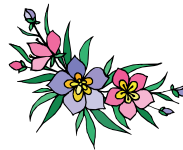

FROM THE VICAR

It is a great relief to us all to feel that the winter has slipped away and we can echo with thankfulness the words of the Song of Solomon from the Old Testament 'For lo, the winter is past, the rain (or snow) is over and gone..The flowers appear on the earth, the time of singing has come...'

These words remind us of the perennial relief at the passing of winter into spring. It is for more than this, though, that we can be thankful. It is Easter or soon will be and we celebrate with joy the good news that Christ is risen from the dead and lives today.

Both the renewal of spring and the resurrection of Our Lord speak to us about the future - its hope and promise. There is after the death of winter the renewal and rebirth of creation all around us with new life both human and otherwise.

And there is also the renewal of our own lives. Two of His disciples met Christ on the road a few days after they saw Him crucified. They did not recognise him, thinking him to be a mere stranger. At the end of their journey they suddenly realise who He is. Christ points out that his suffering on the Cross was necessary and not without a purpose. He calls his disciples afresh and you have only to read in the Bible what then took place. This gives us hope for the renewal of our own lives, and for their ongoing worth and purpose. There is with God always the possibility of resurrection and renewal, for forgiveness, healing and a fresh start. As a well-known hymn expresses it so memorably: 'Strength for today and bright hope for tomorrow, blessings all mine, with ten thousand beside!'

Let us look forward with Christ and allow Our risen Lord to lead us forward to the places to which He would have us go in this year of 2010.
